

Turbine Arrival

Urras Energy was delighted to see the turbine components arriving by ship at Stornoway Harbour last week. They were unloaded between Wednesday and Friday and transported across to Baile an Truiseil as they were being discharged from the vessel. The Enercon installation team arrived in Lewis last Monday evening and commenced operations the following day. Installation of the two turbines will progress over this week and next and, if weather conditions turn out to be as favourable as the forecast suggests, each site could be completed within three days. Electrical cabling would be laid after turbine installation has been finished and that would lead into the commissioning of the turbines which requires another Enercon team to visit the sites.
